Policy Regarding Student Drivers and the Sports Program at the Rudolf Steiner School of Ann Arbor

- 1. In order to drive to any games students and parents must complete the Driving Permission Form.
- 2. Students may not drive to games more than 18 miles from the school.
- 3. Students may drive themselves and a sibling to games within 18 miles of the school.
- 4. Practices: As practices do not take place within the school day, parents are asked to take responsibility for and arrange transportation for their children to and from sport practices.
- 5. If there is a game on a non-school day and the location is closer to the student's home than the school, the student may drive directly to the game location, and then return home, even if the distance exceeds 18 miles.
- 6. Any parent transporting students, other than their own, to or from games must have the following information on file at the school:
 - A. Valid driver license
 - B. Proof of current insurance on vehicle being used to transport students
 - C. A background check done indicating that they have no more than 6 points on their driving record in the previous five years and that they have no restrictions for OUIL.
 - D. Acceptance of personal liability, covered by their insurance policy.
