

RSSAA HS Student Mask and Physical Distancing Policy:

Students from Grade Six to Grade Twelve are expected to wear masks every day at school. Our expectations are:

- You will wear a mask that covers your mouth and nose
- You will wear a mask that is appropriate for school (no inappropriate images) and is not insulting or confrontational
- You will keep your mask on whenever inside – in classrooms, hallways, bathrooms, and offices
- Any students with an exemption will wear a pin to show that they are exempt – see below
- You can take your masks off when outside AND physically distanced by at least 6 feet
- You may ask faculty for a 5 minute mask break when you need one – but time it so that you are not missing key classroom information
- Please use your assigned desks, do not move your desks, and do not stand close to others in the classroom
- When outside and talking to someone (six+ feet away and unmasked) we encourage you to use chairs – chairs don't wander closer
- On the High School Campus the area around the Frame House is reserved for students who do not wish to socially interact when unmasked – students in that area are expected to be entirely solitary.
