The success of the Farm Trip depends on our students continuing to make positive and meaningful contributions to the farm. The expectations for the trip are outlined below.

<u>General Behavior</u>: I understand that the Farm Trip is a school trip and that all school rules apply. This is a science block, and getting credit depends on fulfilling the tasks assigned to me and fulfilling this contract. Credit for the Farm Trip may be revoked for anyone blatantly violating the student contract.

I agree to be respectful of my classmates, inclusive in my interactions, and to refrain from any exclusive, intimate/sexual behavior. I will stay on the farm property during the day, and at the camping property the rest of the time unless I am accompanied by a chaperone and have a specific reason and permission to leave the property. I understand that, under no circumstances am I to enter neighbors' property without direct permission from the teacher chaperones.

<u>Electronics</u>: I understand my phone should be left at home and not be brought to camp or the farm. I agree not to bring other electronic equipment such as video games, video players, computers, tablets, smart watches, mp3 players, iPods, televisions, etc.

Work Ethic: I agree to bring good will to the farm work, the cooking and cleaning duties, and all other activities. This means doing my part, being on time, not complaining, not slacking off, and having fun.

<u>Behavior:</u> I understand that I am representing my school and I agree to be polite and respectful to my classmates, the teachers, chaperones, farmers and co-workers of the farm, and to comply with their instructions. I understand this is a community farm, and that I will make an extra effort to be polite and respectful to Community Farm of Ann Arbor members and visitors on the farm. I understand that I will be camping on the farmer's land, and that I will be respectful and follow the rules at all times.

<u>Camping Expectations</u>: I understand that I am to stay on the property of the farmers at all times while we are camping. I agree to follow the curfew and quiet hours and to let others sleep and/or rest when they wish to. I understand that I may not enter other students' tents at any time without specific permission of the chaperones. I understand that tents are not to be used for socializing during free times, and that social interchanges and "hanging out" is to be done in community spaces. I agree to stay in my tent after the curfew and before wake-up time in the morning, except to use the bathroom if necessary. I understand that leaving my tent at night without permission or leaving the farm property at night is dangerous and will be treated as a cause to be sent home immediately.

<u>Illegal Substances:</u> I agree to not bring or use any tobacco products, electronic vaping devices or paraphernalia, alcohol, marijuana or other drugs. I recognize that doing so will result in my being sent home with no credit for the block, and that doing so will lead to behavioral probation as outlined in the school handbook, and may jeopardize my future at the school. I also understand that if I aid any person in violating these expectations, including any concealment of their behavior, I share responsibility for the behavior and will be sent home along with the student who engages in the inappropriate activity. Any prescription medications should be given to a teacher for safekeeping.
