HEAD: EXCEPTIONAL ACADEMICS

Our curriculum exceeds the requirements of the Michigan Merit Curriculum in all areas. Every one of our students graduates with a full and



balanced credit load of five years of laboratory science, four years of mathematics and English, three years of history and social sciences and four years of art, music and world languages. The depth and breadth of their studies during high school leaves them uniquely

prepared for the challenges of university work.

OUR HOMESTAY PROGRAM

Homestay families are carefully selected and background checked. Families are closely connected to our school community and offer a warm home environment while supporting student activities and encouraging connections with classmates. We check in with families and students regularly to ensure that things are going



well. Homestays generally include housing, all meals, supervision by the host family while the student is not in school, transportation to and from school, and typical activities.

AFTER HIGH SCHOOL

Our students are highly prepared for the next step. Most receive generous merit aid and matriculate to a wide variety of public and private institutions in the US, Canada, Europe and Asia.
