## *Answers to Frequently Asked Questions*

### **When does school start/end?**

High School starts every day at 8:00 am and ends at 3:10 pm Monday-Thursday and 2:40 pm on Friday.

### **What do I do if my student is going to be absent?**

### **What is the lunch program?**

Our lunch program includes a different take-out option for each day of the week. Lunches can be ordered using FACTS or placed directly with the Front Office either by 10am the day of or in some cases the day before. Billing will go through the FACTS system. Please be aware that this year's lunch menu is under construction as there have been a number of price changes from our vendors, some which require revising our offerings. The final menu will be available as we get closer to the start of school. Thank you for your patience.

### **How can I contact a teacher?**

Each RSSAA faculty member has been provided with an email address that is the first initial of the first name followed by their last name @steinerschool.org. More information may be available through the parent portal or you may contact the Front Office. All teachers can also be messaged through the Parent Square messaging option.

### **When does the building close?**

Students are welcome to participate in an after school homework club from 3:30-4:45. No registration is required. Additionally, the school building will be open and supervised daily from the end of school until 5:30 pm. Students are welcome to stay during that time to work on homework, read or study quietly, practice instruments, or attend extracurricular clubs or events. They are expected to be generally quiet and focused on their activities; this after-school time is not for socializing or outdoor/active play. If individual students cannot meet the expectations for this time, they will be asked to leave the school building by 3:30 pm.
