- EC Assistants will be able to move from class to class.
- Desks not 6' apart but moving towards CDC's revised recommendations of 3'.
- We will evaluate pick up and drop off at the Lower School.
- Trips and athletics are being intensely reviewed, even for the 2020-21 school year.

- Even though Parent/Child classes are not specifically mentioned in the plan, they will continue as they are currently being held.
