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Introduction

RSSAA uses three systems to help support students, parents, faculty and staff.

There is some overlap between the systems:

- Teachers could email students or parents through the LMS as well as post to ParentSquare
- Teachers and students could use the chat feature in the LMS as well as ParentSquare
- Long-standing announcements or information could be posted to the Family Portal as well as ParentSquare

ParentSquare

ParentSquare is the primary parent engagement tool for RSSAA. It allows the school to communicate with classes, groups, clubs or individuals. RSSAA uses ParentSquare to post information and events, schedule conferences, request volunteers and accept signed forms and payments. It is also the emergency communication system the school will use to alert families about school closures or emergency situations. All parent(s)/guardians(s) will automatically receive ParentSquare messages to the email address they supplied to the school. You also have the option of creating a login and password (or using single-sign-on with Google or Facebook) and using the ParentSquare website or downloading the iOS or Android app.

- If you’d like to use the app, please download ParentSquare for IOS or ParentSquare for Android.
- If you prefer to use a computer, access ParentSquare from our school’s ParentSquare website. Please bookmark the address: <https://www.parentsquare.com/schools/1655>
- Check your inbox for an invitation email from ParentSquare (check your junk folder if you don’t see it) and click the link in the email to activate your account. Or, from the ParentSquare website you can use your email or cell number on file with the school to create a login.
- Once you’ve logged in, please take the time to watch some short "getting started" videos in the ParentSquare help files.



Family Portal

The FACTS Family Portal is a private and secure parent and student portal.


- The RSSAA Family Portal is accessible from the home page or the "Our Families" menu of our [school website](#) and we also encourage you to bookmark the portal log in page.
- The Family Portal gives parents access to student information, reenrollment information, a school directory and more.
- Students can access the LMS through the portal.

Create your Family Portal Parent Login

You will create your own log in to the Family Portal.

Parent/Guardians:

- Visit our school website and click the Family Portal link on the home page or under "Our Families".
- Our District Code is RS-MI.
- Be sure that the "Parent" button is selected.
- Select "Create New Family Portal Account".
- Use your email that is on file with the school to set up your account.
- An email will be sent which includes a link to create the login. The link is active for 6 hours.
- Enter a User Name, Password, and Confirm the password.

Learning Management System (LMS)

The LMS gives teachers an online location to manage and share class content, host online discussions on a “class wall”, post links to Zoom meetings, create assignments with due dates and generate quizzes and tests if desired. The LMS is not only for remote students, it is also a place for in-person students to participate in virtual class discussions with their classmates, refer to class materials and assignments, and track assignment due dates.

For Early Childhood and grades students, parents will find information on the LMS to help support their student. Frequency of information updates will be decided by the teacher. For middle and high school students, the LMS requires that students (with parent assistance if appropriate) take responsibility for their classes and check it daily. Visiting the LMS is part of going to class.

Each teacher may have a different approach to how they use the LMS for their class, but it is organized to make it easy for students (or parents) to find each class and see what the teacher has posted, upcoming assignments, comments or questions from other students, etc.

Because the LMS is not a communication tool, there are no notifications outside of the LMS desktop. When logged in, users can see notifications in the upper right corner of the screen, but they will not receive a text, app alert or email when something new happens in the LMS. **It is each user’s responsibility to visit the LMS, just like going to class, to get their class information.**

Student LMS Credentials

The Family Portal will be the access point for your student's LMS and requires a separate student log in. It cannot be accessed with the parent log in. Alternatively, the LMS can be accessed at <https://lms.renweb.com/>.

High School Students

High School students will be using the LMS independently. Your student should have their own email address to receive communications from their teachers. Parents can verify if their student has an email address on file with the school or add an email address by logging into the Family Portal. Visit the "Family" section and click the top-center drop down to select your student and view their information. If your student does not have an email address on file with the school, please click the pencil icon next to their name. This will open an edit screen and allow you to add an email address. Alternative, you can contact the front office and let them know your student’s email address so they can add it to the database.

Lower School Students

Lower School students will use the LMS with parent assistance, or in the case of very young students, parents will access the LMS to find their student’s materials.

All Students

When a class begins using the LMS, all students are assigned an LMS username of their first initial and last name (i.e. jsmith). If two family members have the same first initial, then the username will be set to first name and last name (i.e. johnsmith). The default student password is *Steiner1*. Once the student or parent has logged into the Family Portal we recommend the password be changed. If the system registers five incorrect attempts to log in, the account will be locked, and you will need to contact the school to unlock the account.

Access the LMS through Family Portal

- Visit our [school website](#) and click the Family Portal link.
- Our District Code is RS-MI. It is noted on the website drop down menu as a reminder when you access the portal through our website.
- Enter the student username.
- Enter the password Steiner1 (or other if you've changed the password).
- Be sure that the "Student" button is selected.
- Click Log In (if you are logged into the Portal as a parent, you may need to log out and log back in as a student)

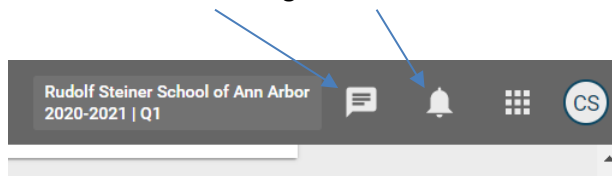
- Once logged in as a student, click the LMS link at the bottom-right of the page.

- The LMS will open in a new tab displaying the student's classes. This will look different for each student.

Microsoft Office 365

All high school students have been assigned a school Microsoft Office 365 account with access to:

- OneDrive – Cloud storage. Students will be assigned a folder for each of their classes.
- Word – Word processing
- Excel – Spreadsheets
- PowerPoint – Presentations

All high school students have been assigned a log in of first initial and last name@steinerschool.org and a password of **Steiner2020**. On their first log in, students will be required to change their password.
